FAIRFIELD, NJ -- Cortegra, a leader in packaging and labeling for pharmaceutical and related industries, announced today that it has purchased the assets of Capital Printing & Graphics of Fairfield, New Jersey. Capital has provided packaging for the generic pharmaceutical and nutraceutical markets for more than 20 years.

The relocation of Capital Printing's assets to Cortegra's facility in Fairfield, New Jersey, will provide enhanced printing capabilities as well as additional inspection and material handling competencies. The equipment transition will be completed by January 2008.

Terms of the transaction were not disclosed. The purchase is the third acquisition Cortegra has made in three years. It also opened a new manufacturing facility in Raleigh, North Carolina, in 2006. Cortegra's three facilities – in Fairfield, New Jersey, Raleigh, North Carolina, and Evansville, Indiana – are ISO 9001 certified.
